Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Why Should I Complete A Risk Assessment?

The HIPAA Security Rule requires that covered entities and its business associates conduct a Risk Assessment of their healthcare organization (Section 164.308(A)(1)(II)(A). The next HIPAA requirement is for the practice to review, understand, and correct any vulnerabilities or deficiencies uncovered by the Risk Assessment.

What Can I Expect During the Risk Review Meeting?

The meeting will be 20-30 minutes. The primary objectives of the meeting are to:

- 1. Help you understand HIPAA requirements
- 2. Review the results of your Risk Assessment
- 3. Explain key vulnerabilities we uncovered
- 4. Discuss solutions to mitigate your risks

Our goal is for you to leave the meeting with a clear understanding of the HIPAA laws and how to correct any vulnerabilities.

What Are The Common Risks And Misconceptions?

Most practices have a false sense of security. Cyber-attacks are up over 300% over the past year. Data breaches, ransomware attacks, and human error are now common, daily occurrences. Is DCDS requiring me to complete a Risk Assessment?

No. The HIPAA Risk Assessment and Review are required under HIPAA Law, but District of Columbia Dental Society is not requiring you to complete it.
